Greetings Coppin Community:

Last week, I shared an update with you that every student and employee of Coppin State University must provide confirmation of COVID-19 test results by August 28, 2020. This is in response to the recent University System of Maryland (USM) announcement for <u>mandatory COVID-19 testing</u> for all students and employees of the twelve institutions.

Testing must have been conducted within 14 days of the date of submission of your results to the university.

We are finalizing plans to have a test site, here, on campus with testing on the following dates:

August 14th and 15th August 21st and 22nd

I am scheduled to be tested on the campus on the first day of testing, August 14. I hope that many of you will join me, and take advantage of our highly-skilled and amazing Coppin State nurses and staff.

I want to thank Dr. Tracey Murray, dean of the College of Health Professions, Dr. Shavon Darden, associate director of the CSU Community Health Center, and their staff, for all the work they are doing to ensure that our campus is as safe as it can be.

Anyone returning to campus for in-person course instruction, residence life, or employment must be tested for COVID-19, prior to their arrival, and must provide designated university officials confirmation of a negative COVID-19 test result.
